## **Rules and Regulations**

1. Queen Contestant/Title holder must be 18-24. Princess Contestant/Title holder must be 13-17 as of September 1, 2009.
2. Contestant/Title holder needs to be a resident of Iron, Washington, Beaver, or Garfield counties.
3. Title holder will NOT be allowed to hold any other titles during her reign as Queen/Princess. Doing so may result in relinquishment of title and prizes.
4. Contestant/Title holder must be prepared to attend all parades, rodeos, and western activities as deemed necessary by the Queen Committee should she win the title of Queen or Princess.
5. Contestant/Title holder will abide by an 11:00 p.m. curfew whenever representing Cedar Lions.
6. Contestant/Title holder must exemplify high morals, refrain from any public displays of affection, and avoid hanging around groups of boys when representing.
7. Contestant/Title holder must not have been married, pregnant, nor become pregnant during the year of reign.
8. Contestant/Title holder must not use tobacco products, even if of legal age.
9. Contestant/Title holder must not use alcoholic beverages, even if of legal age.
10. Contestant/Title holder must not be associated with illegal drugs.
11. Contestant/Title holder must not use profanity in her vocabulary.
12. Contestant's parents must not be in or around area of judging while they are being judged. They must not confront the judge at any time, even after the competition. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
13. Queen contestants speech theme is "Ride." Do exceed 3 minutes, nor go under 2 ½ minutes. Points will be deducted if not within limits.
14. Any infraction of these rules by either a contestant or titleholder may result in disqualification and/or removal and forfeiture of prizes and/or forced resignation upon review of the Cedar City Lions Club.
15. The Queen committee reserves the right and authority to exercise termination of any candidate and/or reigning Queen/Princess in failure to comply.

Queen Horsemanship Pattern*

Ride Pattern as follows within markers:  
Lead horse to \*, mount, lope & slide stop at Point 1 and make a left turn,  
Lope to point 2, Slide Stop.  
Back up to center marker 3, spin 360 to the left, hesitate.  
Spin 1 ¼ to the right, Settle horse.  
Begin to work to the left,  
Do the small figure 8 at a slow lope, switching leads in center.  
Do the large figure 8 at a fast lope.  
Slide stop in center at Point 4,  
Half pivot to the left, settle.  
Trot to Point 5,  
Begin run on left lead to Point 6, Slide Stop.  
Turn away from the rail and make a second run on right lead,  
Slide stop at point 7,  
Back up to 8,  
Half pivot to the right at 9, hesitate.  
Quarter pivot to the left 10, Settle horse.  
Trot the judges at point 11 and stay on horse.  
They will dismiss you to turn to the left and make a presentation ride.  
Stop and dismount at \*

Princess Horsemanship Pattern*

Ride Pattern as follows within markers:  
Lead horse to \*, mount, walk to Point A and make left turn,

Begin to work to the left,  
Do the small figure 8 at a slow lope, switching leads in center.  
Do the large figure 8 at a fast lope.  
Slide stop in center at Point B,  
Half pivot to the left, settle.  
Trot to Point C,  
Begin run on left lead to Point D, Slide Stop.  
Turn away from the rail and make a second run on right lead,  
Slide stop at point E,  
Back up to F,  
Half pivot to the right at G, hesitate.  
Quarter pivot to the left H, Settle horse.  
Trot the judges at point I and stay on horse.  
They will dismiss you to turn to the left and make a presentation ride.  
Stop and dismount at \*
